Dear Mitsubishi Fuso Truck Owner:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

**REASON FOR THIS RECALL:** "Mitsubishi Fuso of America, Inc. (MFTA) has decided that the Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) label on certain vehicles fails to comply with the requirements of Part 567, "Certification." On affected vehicles, the VIN label was misprinted with very low GVWR and GAWR.

**WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:** Please contact MFTA Customer Service toll-free at 877-711-0707 to schedule an appointment to have the VIN label replaced. The Customer Service Representative will record your name, phone number and VIN. They will then forward the information to the MFTA employee who will be performing the corrective action. That MFTA employee will contact you and schedule a time and location to perform the Recall at your convenience. The scheduled time for this corrective action is approximately 1.8 hours.

Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy to the lessee within ten days. If you are the lessor of the above referenced vehicle, please forward this notification immediately.

We at MFTA regret any inconvenience this situation may cause you. However, your safety and continued satisfaction with our product are most important to us.
