SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

SECOND NOTICE - PLEASE READ IMMEDIATELY

April 16, 2008

Dear Victory Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. The Victory Motorcycle Division of Polaris Industries Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some model year 2001 and in some 1999-2000 motorcycles that received transmission replacement kits built in 2001. **This is the second notification of Safety Recall Campaign 06V-298, which was originally sent on November 22, 2006.** This campaign relates to possible transmission gear failure in affected vehicles. Our records indicate that you have purchased a potentially affected vehicle but have not yet had the inspection or repair performed. We urge you to contact your Victory dealer right away and schedule an appointment for this important safety inspection or repair. *If you are certain that the inspection or repair outlined below has already been completed, please disregard this notice.*

The reason for this recall:

Some model year 2001 Victory V92 motorcycles, and some 1999-2000 V92 motorcycles if they received a transmission replacement kit built in 2001, can experience a third gear failure if an abnormal overload condition occurs, such as when shifting at high RPM. If third gear fails, pieces of the gear could become lodged in the transmission; the transmission could lock up, possibly resulting in loss of control and a vehicle crash.

What Victory and your dealer will do:

Victory has issued Safety Recall bulletin V-06-07(A) to all Victory dealers, which outlines the installation of Rear Sprocket Cushion Drive Kit that addresses this issue under the conditions mentioned above. The bulletin also includes an inspection procedure for 1999-2000 models to determine if your vehicle is affected. Repairs will be made by any authorized Victory motorcycle dealer at no cost to you.

What you should do:

2001 Owners: Please call your authorized Victory motorcycle dealer to schedule an appointment.

1999-2000 Owners: If your motorcycle has the original transmission, your motorcycle is not affected. Please disregard this notice.

If you have had a transmission kit installed (or if you're not sure), please contact your dealer to determine if it is affected. It is important to note that only transmission kits produced in 2001 are affected. Original transmissions and kits produced after 2001 are not affected. If your dealer determines that your transmission kit is affected, please schedule an appointment to have the bulletin work performed.

If you have questions or if you need more information:

While your Victory dealer is in the best position to answer your questions, if you have any questions that your dealer cannot address, if you are having difficulty obtaining the recall repair outlined in this letter, or if you need assistance finding a Victory Dealer, please contact our Victory Consumer Service Department by calling 1-888-704-5290 or visit the Polaris/Victory Motorcycle web site at www.polarisindustries.com.

This notice was mailed to you according to our most current registration information. If you no longer own your Victory motorcycle, please contact your local Victory dealer to have the ownership information changed. The Consumer Service Department cannot change ownership information without identification. Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within 10 days.

If you believe that the Victory Motorcycle Division of Polaris Industries Inc. has failed to remedy this defect without charge or is unable to do so within a reasonable time, you may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE., Washington, D.C. 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or on the web go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.

Please accept our apologies for any inconvenience this may cause you. Your safety and continued satisfaction with your Victory motorcycle is our primary concern. Thank you for your prompt attention to this matter.
