ON CERTAIN MOTOR HOMES, THE TV IS NOT SECURED SUFFICIENTLY AND COULD FALL OUT WHEN THE MOTORHOME IS MOVING.

Consequence:

THE TV COULD SLIDE OUT WHEN UNIT IS IN MOTION INCREASING THE RISK OF PERSONAL INJURY TO VEHICLE OCCUPANTS.

Remedy:

DEALERS WILL SCREW THE TV INTO THE CABINET SECURELY FREE OF CHARGE. THE RECALL BEGAN ON APRIL 2, 2007. OWNERS MAY CONTACT TIFFIN AT 256-356-8661.

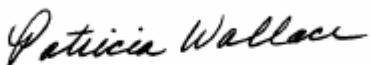
It is our understanding that notification to owners began during April 2007, prior to our review of the owner notification letter. Should it become necessary for Tiffin to do a renotification, the follow-up notification must be submitted to this office for review and it must comply with the requirements of Part 577.5, "Notification pursuant to a manufacturer's decision" and Part 577.10, "Follow-up notification."

Copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification began during April 2007. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on or before July 30, 2007.
