ON CERTAIN MOTOR HOMES, THE EXTERIOR SLIDEOUT STORAGE DRAWER CAN INADVERTENTLY SLIDE OUT DURING NORMAL HIGHWAY OPERATION.

**Consequence:**

THIS COULD IMPACT NEARBY PERSONS OR OBJECTS RESULTING IN PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR VEHICLE AND PROPERTY DAMAGE.

**Remedy:**

DEALERS WILL INSTALL A SECONDARY CATCH ON THESE MOTOR HOMES. THE MANUFACTURER HAS NOT YET PROVIDED AN OWNER NOTIFICATION SCHEDULE. OWNERS MAY CONTACT WINNEBAGO AT 1-614-585-3535.

This recall was the subject of a Preliminary Evaluation, PE06-058, conducted by the Office of Defects Investigation.


Please provide the following additional information and be reminded of the following requirements:
