
Land Rover is updating this letter to revise the end date of the recall and the number of involved vehicles. Land Rover has learned that the interim containment actions that were the original basis for the end date of the recall were not 100% effective. As such, Land Rover has decided to extend the recall to the date of the permanent corrective actions implemented by the fuel tank assembly supplier.

Information in the Part 573.6 (c) (2) section is being revised to provide information concerning the scope of the affected vehicles. Information in the Part 573.6 (c) (3) section is being revised to provide the number of supplemental involved vehicles. Information in the Part 573.6 (c) (8) section is being revised to provide the owner notification timing for the supplemental vehicles. Finally, information in the Part 573.6 (c) (11) section is being revised to provide a revised recall number to simplify Land Rover's administration of the supplement to this recall.

Pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Defect and Noncompliance Reports, Land Rover submits the following information concerning a safety recall action that it is voluntarily initiating.

573.6 (c) (2) - Potentially Affected Vehicles

Certain 2005-2006 model year LR3 petrol vehicles built at the Solihull (UK) Assembly Plant from July 1, 2004, through September 28, 2005, VIN range SALAA25425A000360 to SALAG25456A359153, are potentially affected.

573.6 (c) (3) -- Estimated Population of Vehicles Potentially Affected

Originally 17,256 vehicles and a supplementary 6,116 vehicles in the United States and Federalized Territories.

573.6 (c) (8) Service Program

Land Rover plans to notify owners of the supplemental vehicles during the week of January 29, 2007.

573.6 (c) (11) -- Recall Number

Land Rover has assigned recall number P001 to this supplemental action.
