49 CFR Part 573 – DEFECT INFORMATION REPORT
B016 – CERTAIN 2005-2006 MODEL YEAR LAND ROVER LR3 VEHICLES – PETROL FUEL
TANKS

Pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Defect and Noncompliance Reports, Ford submits the following information amending that previously provided concerning a safety recall action that its wholly owned subsidiary, Land Rover, is voluntarily initiating.

573.6 (c) (8) Service Program

In the December 15, 2006, notification letter, which expanded the original scope of Recall B016 (P001), it was stated that Land Rover would notify the additional owners during the week of January 29, 2007. Regrettably, Land Rover is unable to obtain a sufficient supply of fuel tank assemblies to support this timing. Unforeseen equipment failures at the fuel tank supplier have delayed the production of the replacement tanks.

Land Rover now plans to notify owners during the week of February 26, 2007.

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
