Re: Non-compliance Report

On January 17, 2007, Fleetwood Enterprises Inc., decided that a non-compliance to Section 6.2.6 "Marking of Alternate Exits" of the 2005 Edition of the ANSI/NFPA 1192 Standard on Recreational Vehicles exists in motor homes as listed below and is furnishing this notification in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- The report was prepared on January 23, 2007.
  - Fleetwood has assigned 70122 as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiaries of Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in this recall are 2007 model year Excursion and Providence 40E model motor homes manufactured from September 12, 2006 through December 20, 2006. The December 20, 2006 date coincides with the appropriate identification (exit label and red egress latches) of the alternate exit / emergency egress window being installed during production. These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of 772E74498291 through 772E74499278 and 779E74497556 through 779E74499216.

- (3) Fleetwood reports 93 as an approximate number of Excursion and Providence 40E model motor homes containing the non-compliance.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the above Excursion and Providence 40E model motor homes contain the non-compliance.
- (5) On Excursion and Providence 40E model motor homes affected by this recall the dinette alternate exit /emergency egress window is not identified by an exit label and red egress latches as required by ANSI/NFPA 1192 section 6.2.6.
- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in January, 2007 when the non-compliance was discovered at our manufacturing plant.

Fleetwood is not aware of any accidents or injuries that have resulted from this non-compliance.

- (8) The recall remedy consists of installing exit labels and red egress latches as required by ANSI/NFPA 1192. Fleetwood Enterprises Inc. will provide this recall remedy at no charge to the customer.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification mailing on February 16, 2007. Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification mailing on February 23, 2007.

Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.

- (10) Copies of subsequent correspondence will be submitted to the NHTSA within five (5) working days of distribution. The correspondence will include:
  - I) Letter of dealer notification
  - II) Letter of customer notification
  - III) Service Bulletin
