5. Description of Noncompliance

Suzuki Motor Corporation has decided that certain 2007 Suzuki XL7 vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Page 2 Suzuki Part 573 Report

Vehicle Safety Standard No. 212, Windshield Mounting. An incorrect primer was used when installing the windshield on these vehicles.

6. Chronology of Principal Events

May 25, 2007	-	CAMI Automotive Inc. informed American Suzuki Motor Corporation (ASMC) about a possible concern with XL7 vehicles.
May 26, 2007	-	ASMC issued a stop sale notice to dealers.
June 13, 2007		Suzuki Motor Corporation decided to conduct a noncompliance recall.

7. Description of Corrective Action

ASMC will conduct a safety-related recall campaign for affected vehicles, to replace any windshields that were installed using an incorrect primer. For affected vehicles in dealer inventory, an inspection is being conducted to identify any glass (windshield glass, rear liftgate glass, or side stationary glass) that was installed using an incorrect primer. Any glass found to have been installed using an incorrect primer will be replaced. For affected vehicles that have been sold to customers, Suzuki dealers will replace the windshield glass, rear liftgate glass, and stationary side glass.

ASMC is planning to notify dealers about the recall on June 14, 2007, and currently expects to notify customers about the recall by the end of June, 2007.

Since the cost of any pre-notification repairs would have been covered under warranty, ASMC understands that it is not necessary to specify a reimbursement plan or notify owners about eligibility for reimbursement of the cost of pre-notification repairs.

Dear Sir/Madam,

We regret to inform you that certain 2007MY XL7 (JC636) model vehicles may have a production problem related to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS).

Therefore, Suzuki motor corporation has decided to conduct a Non compliance recall campaign to address this problem.

We would like to request you to kindly take the following actions as below. Also, please notify this campaign to your government or entity.

1. CONDITION

Certain 2007MY XL7 (JC636) model vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 212, Windshield Mounting. On some of these vehicles, an incorrect primer may have been used when installing the windshield. In the event of a crash, the windshield may not be retained to the extent required by the Standard, increasing the risk of personal injuries to the vehicle occupants.

The same primer may have also been applied to the back door window and the quarter window.

2. AFFECTED VEHICLE INFORMATION

3. ACTION

- Contact the owners of the affected vehicles to let them bring their vehicles to your authorized dealers.
- For vehicles in customer possession, dealers are to replace the windshield, the back door window and the quarter window. Follow the procedure instruction provided by CAMI.
- For vehicles in dealer inventory, dealers are to hold the vehicle. CAMI representative will inspect the affected vehicles for the windshield, the back door window and the quarter window. at each dealership. If the inspector identified improperly mounted glass, the improper glass of any or all windshield, the back door window and the quarter window must be replaced with replacement glass, new primer and new urethane. Follow the procedure instruction provided by CAMI.

4. REPLACEMENT PARTS SUPPLY PLAN

You are kindly requested to place an order to SUZUKI Spare Parts Department by regular ordering procedure for the replacement parts according to the part number information provided by CAMI.

5. COST REIMBURSEMENT

The cost incurred for this recall campaign will be reimbursed by CAMI. Please submit claim data and invoice directly to CAMI.

Supplemental instructions to the stationary glass replacement procedures.

1. Cut out glass holding cut out tool to edge of glass. Very important steps to insure a safe repair.

2. Prepare window opening by cutting excess urethane from body. 2.1 During cut out process, pull and peel all loose (not securely bonded) urethane away. 2.2 Examine and check, (a second time) for securely bonded urethane, removing any loose urethane.

2.3 Where urethane is securely bonded, skim cut the urethane leaving 0.5 mm (.02 in) to 2.0 mm

(.08 in) on the flange.

- 2.4 Cut urethane to remove any ridges, notches, or divots.
- 2.5 Clean any loose pieces of urethane from opening.
- 3. Repair of body bonding surface.
 - 3.1 Locate any areas where the primer/urethane did not adhere to the paint surface.
 - 3.2 If residual primer exists adjacent to area the bonding area, remove and de-gloss with 200 grit automotive grade sandpaper.
 - 3.3 Clean the bonding surface using a low lint paint shop quality rag dampened with 99% Isopropyl Alcohol (IPA) and allow to dry.
 - 3.4 Shake container of black (9985757, YH R C-50KE) or equivalent body primer 5 minutes prior to use.
 - 3.5 Apply black body primer to areas where urethane did not adhere and as needed adjacent to skim cut bead. Apply to any exposed metal on the flange. DO NOT APPLY BLACK PRIMER TO ANY EXISTING URETHANE.
 - 3.6 Allow black body primer to dry a minimum 2 minutes prior to installing glass.

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Glass Preparation

- 1. Glass must be clean, dry and free of contaminates prior to primer application.
 - 1.1 Wipe glass with a clean, low lint, paint shop quality rag and 99% Isopropyl Alcohol (IPA), prior to black glass primer application.
 - 1.2 Re-wipe interior side black ceramic bonding surface (frit) with a clean, low lint, paint shop quality rag and 99% Isopropyl Alcohol (IPA), in preparation for black glass primer application, (9982279, YH MS-90) or equivalent.
- 2. Allow IPA to dry prior to application of black glass primer.
- 3. Apply black glass primer, (9982279, YH MS-90) or equivalent to glass using original/provided dimensions and locations.
- NOTICE: The glass primer application must be continuous and streak free in the bonding area.
 - 3.1 Re-apply black glass primer if a second coat is necessary.

Urethane Application

- 1. Apply a continuous bead of urethane adhesive (9985397, YH WS-70FK) or equivalent over the previously applied glass primers. The bead should be a minimum of 14 mm (.55 in) high and 8mm (.3 in) wide at the base, in the shape of a blunt triangle.
- NOTICE: Use of an alternative method of urethane application, "bead applied to body," is not recommended. At no time should application of the urethane to the glass and installation of the glass exceed 5 minutes.
- 2. Install glass to vehicle within the 5 minute limit.
- 3. If this time is exceeded, scrape/remove urethane and reapply for new installation.
- 4. Upon installation, check left / right positioning (centering) and lightly press glass into position.
- 5. Clean any excess urethane adhesive on visible surfaces by wiping immediately with a paint shop quality rag dampened with VM&P Naphtha or equivalent.
- 6. Position glass to ensure that rear edge of upper reveal molding does not have a gap to the roof surface, by shifting the windshield upward.
- 7. If required, use masking tape to hold the molding to the body during urethane cure.

MODEL: Certain 2007 XL7 Models

Suzuki Motor Corporation has decided certain 2007 Suzuki XL7 vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 212, Windshield Mounting.

Affected vehicles may have had glass installed where incorrect body primer was used. In the event of a crash, the windshield may not be retained as required by the FMVSS standard, increasing the risk of injury. The same primer may have been applied to the back door window glass and quarter windows.

1. Affected Vehicles

Only the specific vehicle identification numbers (VIN) on ATTACHMENT A.

2. Owner Notification

Few vehicles have been retailed. ASMC will notify all retail owners of this Important Safety Recall by mail and by telephone beginning on or around June 21, 2007, when adequate parts supply is available.

3. Dealer Safety Recall Campaign Responsibility

Customer Vehicles:

Replace windshield, side quarter windows, and back door window following the instructions in this bulletin. These vehicles will be listed in the affected VIN list. Suzuki recommends the use of a certified glass installer for this repair.

Dealers are to perform this Safety Recall on all affected customer owned vehicles upon request, regardless of vehicle age, mileage or date of visit. If an affected vehicle is currently in your Service Department or is brought in for other service, use this opportunity to perform this safety recall and notify the customer of the campaign completion.

In Stock Vehicles:

Based on factory representative inspections conducted at each dealership, remove and replace the glass identified by the inspector; any or all windshield, quarter windows, and back door window. Suzuki recommends the use of a certified glass installer for this repair. If inspection confirms that the vehicle does not require repairs, reassemble the vehicle and prepare for normal sales inventory.

Affected in-dealer stock inventory, subject to this Safety Recall Campaign must be inspected and if repairs are required, those repairs completed prior to retail sale or lease of the vehicle. It is a violation of Federal law for a dealer to deliver a new motor vehicle until the defect or noncompliance is remedied.

- NOTE: For vehicles inspected by factory inspectors and found to need repairs. Specific part numbers as listed above will be replaced, based upon inspector direction. For vehicles passed by the inspectors, dealers may offer them for sale immediately; they are released form "Stop Sale".

6. Notes

- A) Only "Connect" claims will be processed for this Important Safety Recall.
- B) Only one variation code per vehicle will be allowed.
- C) Courtesy Vehicle Replacement Program will apply as necessary.

7. Time and Mileage Limits

Applicable time and mileage limits do not apply.

8. Warranty Parts Retention

Parts for this campaign do not need to be retained for the normal retention period. Scrap all removed parts; do not re-use.

9. Dealer Recall Responsibility

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act provides that each vehicle involved in a recall of this type must be repaired within a reasonable time after the customer tenders it for repair. If the condition is not adequately repaired within a reasonable time, the customer may be entitled to an identical or reasonably equivalent vehicle at no charge or to a refund of the purchase price less a reasonable allowance for depreciation. Effort must be made to promptly schedule an appointment with each customer and to repair their vehicle as soon as possible. In the recall notification letters, customers are told how to contact Suzuki Customer Relations, and the US National Highway Traffic Safety Administration if the recall is not competed within a reasonable time.

This bulletin is also formal notice that the new motor vehicles included in this recall may not comply with the standard identified above. Under Title 49, Section 20112 of the United States Code, it is illegal for a dealer to sell a new motor vehicle which the dealer knows does not comply with an applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard. As a consequence, if you sell any of these motor vehicles without first performing the recall correction, your dealership may be subject to a civil penalty for each such sale. All unsold new vehicles in dealers' possession and subject to this recall <u>must</u> be held and inspected/repaired per Suzuki instructions <u>before</u> customers take possession of these vehicles.

10. Customer Notification

American Suzuki will mail the attached letter on or around June 21, 2007. American Suzuki will also call all affected customers to help answer questions and promote appointment setting to ensure optimal satisfaction.

In the event of a crash, the windshield glass may not be retained to the extent required by FMVSS No. 212, increasing the risk of personal injuries to vehicle occupants.

Your servicing dealer will order and install a new windshield, and will also replace the glass in the rear liftgate and fixed side windows. There will be no charge to you for parts or labor.
