Re: Recall 07V356 Supplemental 573 Defect Notice Remedy Change

Dear Mr. Smith:

This report supplements Big Dog Motorcycles, LLC's August 6, 2007 defect notice concerning a safety defect involving a short circuit in the voltage regulator on certain MY 2005 and 2006 Big Dog models. After further review of this issue with its voltage regulator supplier, R.E. Phelon Company, Big Dog has decided to modify its remedy for this recall, as described below.

Revised Remedy Program

Big Dog will replace the existing circuit breaker located between the voltage regulator positive battery lead (B+ lead) and the positive battery terminal with an alternative circuit protection device that will prevent a thermal event if there is a short to ground.

A copy of Big Dog's revised owner letter will be submitted for your review shortly. Big Dog is prepared to send out its revised owner letter during the first week of December, 2007.
