Dear Mr. Smith:

The following information is submitted pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6 as it applies to a determination by General Motors of a safety defect involving certain 2008 model year Hummer H2 model vehicles.

573.6(c)(1): Hummer Brand of General Motors Corporation

573.6(c)(2)(3)(4): This information is shown on the attached sheet.

573.6(c)(5): General Motors has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2008 model year HUMMER H2 vehicles. Certain wires in the ABS wheel speed sensor front or rear harness may be reversed. This condition could result in increased stopping distance under certain circumstances.

573.6(c)(6): On July 25, 2007, GM discovered the subject condition on vehicles at the Mishawaka, Indiana assembly plant.

It was determined by GM Engineering that with this condition present, an ABS-controlled braking event could result in increased stopping distance on a split-coefficient road surface. Additionally, increased steering input could be required to maintain vehicle direction.

The issue was presented to the Field Performance Evaluation Review Committee and on August 14, 2007, the Executive Field Action Decision Committee decided to conduct a safety recall.

573.6(c)(8): Dealers are to correct the ABS wheel speed sensor wiring, if necessary and reprogram the brake control module.

Pursuant to 577.11(e), GM does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because all involved vehicles are covered under the new vehicle warranty.

573.6(c)(9): General Motors will provide copies of the dealer bulletin, owner letter and mail dates when available.
