RE: **Recall 07V404000**

Dear Associate Administrator:

Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Monaco Coach Corporation (“Monaco” or the “Company”) is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a safety recall that was previously filed on August 31, 2007 with the following amendments:

573.5(c)(2)

The affected vehicles include the following Class A Motorhomes:

Holiday Rambler: 2007-2008 Ambassador (40), 2007-2008 Scepter (26), 2007-2008 Endeavor (95) and 2007-2008 Neptune (66)

Monaco: 2007-2008 Camelot (50), 2007-2008 Diplomat (156), 2007-2008 Knight (66), 2007-2008 Cayman (67) and 2007 Lapalma Diesel (1)

Safari: 2007 Cheetah (9), 2007-2008 Trek Gas (12) and 2007-2008 Simba Diesel (3)

Beaver: 2007-2008 Contessa (39)

The affected motorhomes were manufactured from December 12, 2006 through May 23, 2007.

573.5(c)(3)

A total of **six hundred and seventy seven** (677) Class A motorhomes are in the total recall population. Of this total, **six hundred and thirty** (630) are in the recall population for the United States and **forty seven** (47) were exported.

573.5(c)(4)

One hundred and five (105) motorhomes in the United States recall population have been repaired; therefore **five hundred and twenty five** (525) motorhomes are needing to be repaired, or approximately 83% of the recall population for the United States. As an additional note, Atwood sold five affected units to our Monaco Service Center to be installed as an aftermarket installation. These five are not included in the recall population above and Monaco will contact those five separately to have repaired.

The recall population was determined from purchasing records of the affected ranges and cooktops supplied by Atwood Mobile Products ("Atwood") and the manufacturing records for the Company's manufacturing facilities in Wakarusa, Indiana and Coburg, Oregon which produced the affected vehicles.



Monaco and Atwood expects owner notification to begin on November 21, 2007 which is immediately after the five day 577 approval time. An Atwood authorized dealer will conduct this service procedure at no charge to the customer.

A copy of Atwood's owner (part 577) and dealer notification letters are attached for your approval. Atwood will be mailing owner notifications and conducting this recall on behalf of Monaco and updating Monaco of completed units and Monaco will be reporting quarterly to NHTSA. Monaco has supplied Atwood with an updated owner and address list of information for vehicles containing these potentially affected ranges and slide-in cook tops.
