Utilimaster Corp is submitting this defect information report in accordance with the requirements of 49 CFR Part 573.6.

(1) Manufacturer

(2) Identification of Subject Vehicles

Utilimaster's Aeromaster line of walk-in delivery vans, (built on various chassis), equipped with headlight modules (P/N's 15206129 and 16513036) purchased from ATC Lighting & Plastics, Inc. The subject vehicles were manufactured from June 8, 2007 through August 21, 2007.

(3) Total Number of Vehicles Potentially Containing Defect

There are 454 total vehicles potentially affected, sold to the Customers listed on the attached sheet.

(4) Percentage of Vehicles Estimated to Contain Defect

Approximately 5%.

(5) Description of Defect

The headlight modules installed on these walk-in vans are purchased as an assembly. The module incorporates a three-conductor harness to connect the headlamp to the power supply. On some modules the wires are switched causing the headlamp to operate with reduced effectiveness. The defect is internal to the module but can be accessed by the removal of the headlamp. Utilimaster is unaware of any property damage or personal injury as a result of this condition.

(6) Chronology of Events

In late-August, 2007, a customer notified Utilimaster that the headlights on some of their vehicles were dim. During the investigation it was determined that the headlight module was wired incorrectly. Based upon testing and evaluation conducted by Utilimaster and ATC, Utilimaster decided on September 18, 2007 to conduct a safety recall.

(7) Description of Remedy

Utilimaster will provide detailed instructions for the verification and repair of the wiring defect. Customers will be reimbursed for the labor cost of the repairs.

Utilimaster will forward a draft customer letter to NHTSA in the next several days, and is prepared to send out the customer letter immediately after clearance by NHTSA/ODI.

(8) Reimbursement Program

Utilimaster will reimburse the customer for 0.1 hours of their standard labor rate for the inspection of the lights. If the headlight needs to be repaired, Utilimaster will pay 0.25 hours of their standard labor rate for the inspection and repair of the light.
