1. Manufacturer's Name/Address:

The manufacturer of vehicles covered by this Report is:

J&L Cargo Express
708 South Division Street
Bristol, IN 47507

2. Vehicles Involved:

The vehicles covered by this report are cargo trailers with living quarters (recreational vehicles) that were equipped with certain models of refrigerators manufactured by Dometic Corporation between April 1997 and May 2003. The vehicle models in questions are as follows:

J&L Cargo Express
Overland
Express Living Quarters.

The vehicles were manufactured during a period of April 1997 and December 2003.

3. Total Number of Vehicles:

The total number of vehicles covered by this Report is 50. Although we only purchased a total of 31 units from the manufacturer Dometic Corporation during that time-frame, we have opted to include all units with refrigerators manufactured by the company, to allow for the benefit of doubt as to which units did or did not contain a refrigerator by Dometic Corporation.

4. Approximate Percentage of Vehicles Estimated to Actually Contain the Defect:

Based on the information received from Dometic, J&L Cargo Express believes that approximately .06 percent of those vehicles actually contain the defect.

5. Description of the Defect:

Under some circumstances, a fatigue crack can develop in the boiler tube of the covered refrigerators, which can permit the release of pressurized coolant solution. If this solution is exposed to an ignition source under certain specific circumstances, it can result in a vehicle fire.

6. Chronological Summary of Events leading to this Determination:

Dometic advised J&L Cargo Express of its defect determination by letter as requested from Dometic after receipt of a reminder letter from NHTSA, dated August 20, 2007. J&L Cargo Express is not aware of any fires in its vehicles that appear to be related to this defect. Nevertheless, after reviewing the matter, J&L Cargo Express decided to submit this defect report.

7. Program for Remediating the Defect:

Dometic has arranged to conduct a recall to remedy the potential defect in J&L Cargo Express's vehicles at no charge to the vehicle owners. Re: Recall No. 06E-076. Pursuant to 49CFR 573.6(c)(8)(i) and 573.13, owners will be advised that Dometic will reimburse them if they have incurred costs to obtain a remedy for a refrigerator containing a defect prior to the receipt of the notification.

8. Recall Strategy:

Through a third party contracted by Dometic Corporation, Stericycle of Indianapolis IN, we have provided them with a comprehensive listing of all Models, and associated V.I.N.'s, along with the names of any 1st registered owners, which they will contact in an approved format. They will research all necessary Motor Vehicle Registration data base information to secure all relevant owner information necessary to inform owners of the Recall and the remediation offered. In subsequent reporting to NHTSA and Cargo Express, information regarding the completeness of the process will be made.

RE: Defect Information Report; Vehicles Equipped with Certain Refrigerators
Manufactured by Dometic Corporation

Dear Valued Customer:

J&L Cargo Express the parent company for Cargo Express Trailers, Overland and Express Living Quarters, has been advised by Dometic Corporation that certain Dometic refrigerators installed as original equipment in some of J & L Cargo Express vehicles with living quarters, may contain a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety because they may experience a leak of pressurized coolant solutions which can result in a vehicle fire under certain specific circumstances.

On the basis of that Dometic determination, J&L Cargo express has decided that there may be a potential safety defect in its vehicles equipped with the identified refrigerators, and we are therefore submitting the enclosed Defect information Report pursuant to 49CFR part 573.
