Subject: Safety Recall, SC0323, Fuel Injection Line Sleeve

Safety Recall Summary:

On certain Mack model vehicles (CH, CHN, CX, and CXN) manufactured with fuel injection line sleeves from October 2006 through January 2007 and on vehicles that had the sleeves installed as a result of repairs associated with safety recall SC0317, there exists the possibility that the sleeves may chafe the fuel injection line. This may compromise the fuel injection line over time, which possibly could result in an engine fire.

The number of vehicles affected is approximately 6,798 (5,943 US and 855 Canada).

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Repair Instructions are tentatively scheduled for release on or before April 6, 2007.
- Vehicle list is tentatively scheduled to be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal on or before April 3, 2007.
- Owner Notices are tentatively scheduled to be mailed on or before April 19, 2007.
