Based on information from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) website, the media may report that General Motors will be announcing a safety recall involving certain 2008 Hummer H2 Utility and SUT vehicles.

Certain wires in the Antilock Brake System (ABS) wheel speed sensor front or rear harness may be reversed. This condition could result in increased stopping distance under certain circumstances. Additionally, increased steering input could be required to maintain vehicle direction.

To correct this condition, dealers are to correct the ABS wheel speed sensor wiring, if necessary and reprogram the brake control module.

A total of 363 vehicles are involved. Dealers will be notified when customer notification letters are scheduled to be mailed.

GM Vehicle Inquiry System (GMVIS) information for this recall will not be available until the recall bulletin is released to dealers.
