Attention Dealer TCI Dealer:

This notice is sent in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. No. 577.13, *Notification to dealers and distributors.*

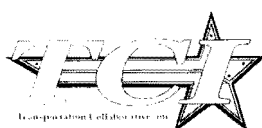
Transportation Collaborative Inc. on Behalf of US Bus Corporation has decided that a defect exist , which relates to motor vehicle safety, on certain 2007 Sturdivus, Universe and Safetran School Buses built on GMT 610 Chevrolet Express Chassis 2000-2006 manufactured between September 1,2006 and September 30, 2007. The vehicles involved have a VIN range between 71205402-71904846 or 71209474-71231106.

The defect involves Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108 “ *Lamps ,reflective devices and associated equipment* “ Specifically, this defect is with General Motors Corporation's Anti-lock Brake System Module. During normal use of the brake pedal, the rear stoplights will illuminate. When the brake pedal is released, the rear stoplights will no longer be illuminated but the rear brakes may still be engaged. The brakes may release after a few seconds or after the next firm brake pedal application. The vehicle driver may experience substantial drag while the vehicle is in motion and may need to depress the gas pedal further than normal to continue vehicle movement.

In the event that a vehicle is driven with, the brakes applied can cause overheating of brakes, resulting in increased stopping distance, which could result in a vehicle crash. Possibly leading to personal injury or death to the passengers or pedestrians.

The remedy for this defect is to have the vehicle brought to a GM or Chevrolet Dealer to have the Anti- Lock Brake System Module reprogrammed. Customer will be asked to fill out response card provided information that the recall performed and send it back to TCI. TCI will work with General Motors Corporation to ensure that customers have their vehicles inspected for the defect and repaired at no cost.

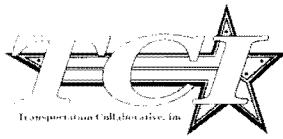
In order to ensure that all vehicles that are subject to the recall are corrected, we will perform the following actions:

The Remedy:

General Motor Corporation dealers will need to reprogram the Anti-lock Brake System Module free of charge.

What we are requesting you do:

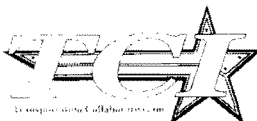
