Subject: Upcoming Noncompliance Recall 07281
Headliner and A-Pillar Trim

Models: 2007 Chevrolet Equinox and Pontiac Torrent Vehicles Built Prior to
March 22, 2007 and not Equipped with Optional
Roof Rail Air Bags or Optional Sunroof

To: All Chevrolet and Pontiac Dealers

Attention: Dealer Operator, General Manager, Sales Manager, Service Manager,
Used Car Manager, Parts Manager and Warranty Administrator

Based on information from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) website, the media may report that General Motors will be announcing a noncompliance recall involving certain 2007 model year Chevrolet Equinox and Pontiac Torrent vehicles built prior to March 22, 2007 and not equipped with optional Roof Rail Air Bags or optional Sunroof.

These vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 201, "Occupant Protection in Interior Impact." In tests, one of the interior occupant protection test points exceeded the Standard's requirement.

To correct this condition, dealers are to install an energy-absorbing foam piece to each of the A-pillar trim assemblies.

A total of 57,100 vehicles are involved. GM anticipates releasing the dealer bulletin and mailing customer notification letters in January 2008.

GM Vehicle Inquiry System (GMVIS) information for this recall will not be available until the recall bulletin is released to dealers.
