NON-COMPLIANCE RECALL 60701-C

JULY 2007

Dear Workhorse Custom Chassis Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Workhorse® has decided that gasoline fuel tanks on certain P42 and W42 chassis built 8/27/2001 thru 9/25/2006 fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 301 Fuel System Integrity.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Vehicle testing revealed that the fuel pump/sending unit's retaining ring may come loose, allowing fuel spillage after a vehicle rollover.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Fuel spillage during a vehicle crash may contribute to a fire possibly resulting in personal injury, property damage or death.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

PLEASE contact your local Workhorse Dealer to schedule an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. You may locate your nearest Workhorse dealer by calling (877) 946-7731 or by visiting:

The repair will involve replacing the fuel sending unit's retaining ring.

Dealers will have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle by 7/13/2007.

This will be performed *free of charge* and may take approximately *2.5 hours* to complete.

Our records indicate you are the owner of the chassis identified on the enclosed card. If you do not own this chassis, please fill out the **Authorization for Recall Service** card so you will not be contacted again regarding this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE
