Dear Peterbilt Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Bendix Commercial Vehicle Systems LLC has notified Peterbilt Motors Company that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some models 357, 367, 335, 340, and 320 manufactured September 19, 2006 through May 31, 2007. Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured with this defect.

Suspect valves have a defective internal check valve. Intermittently, the parking brakes may be delayed or may fail to apply when the operator sets the parking brake. There is a potential for the vehicle to roll away which may cause an accident that could result in personal injury or death. This condition was determined to be a safety-related defect.

Peterbilt Motors Company has initiated a recall to repair the spring brake modulating valve. Please contact your Peterbilt dealer immediately to schedule an appointment. This should take no more than 1 hour and these parts are provided at no charge to you. If you have already had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

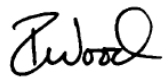
