Dear Peterbilt Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Peterbilt Motors has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some vehicles manufactured between June 26, 2007 and July 31, 2007 with either 135 or 150 gallon fuel tanks. Your vehicle has been identified as having been manufactured within this time period and may contain this defect.

The longitudinal seam weld on suspect fuel tanks is inadequate. Fuel tanks possessing this defect could leak diesel fuel in the event of a collision. A leaking fuel tank could result in a potential fire which may result in personal injury or property damage.

<i>The problem is...</i>	Inadequate longitudinal seam weld on 135 and 150 gallon fuel tanks
<i>What your dealer will do...</i>	Replace the fuel tanks
<i>What you must do ...</i>	Contact your dealer immediately to schedule an appointment to replace the fuel tanks

Peterbilt Motors Company has initiated a recall to replace your fuel tanks. Please contact your Peterbilt dealer immediately to schedule an appointment. This should take no more than 2.7 hours per tank and will be performed at no charge to you. If you have already had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

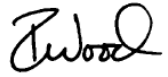
