This letter is written to notify the NHTSA that Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., is aware of the voluntary initiation of a recall notification campaign affecting Fleetwood produced recreational vehicles as listed below:

Class A Motor Homes - Model Year 2007 - 2008

American Eagle	manufactured 9/1/06 through 8/8/07
American Tradition	manufactured 8/9/06 through 8/10/07
Revolution LE	manufactured 6/11/07 through 7/3/07

This voluntary recall campaign involves approximately 169 Fleetwood Class A motor homes manufactured with Spartan chassis.

Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the above motor homes contain the safety defect. This is based on the Part 573 defect report that Spartan Chassis provided to Fleetwood on November 13, 2008 and also submitted to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration on December 17, 2007.

The reason for the recall is Spartan Chassis, Inc., has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain Spartan Chassis models produced with a Bussmann® (DVEC) dual vehicle electrical center.

Lower mileage vehicles may experience an electrical power loss to major chassis operating systems (engine, transmission, starting, cooling) causing the vehicle to shutdown and/or prevent powering up. Each vehicle could potentially experience a unique circumstance where one or a

combination of the following conditions could occur; Loss of electrical power to the engine, transmission, starting and engine cooling systems, in operation of the light chassis stop/turn signal and right trailer stop/turn signal, the anti-lock brake system (ABS), the auxiliary brake system, the heater elements in the air dryer, and the water-in-fuel separator, which could result in a crash.

Authorized Spartan Chassis Service Centers will replace the Bussmann® DVEC, per safety bulletin #07V-363.

Fleetwood has no reason to disagree with this action or the recall remedy. Fleetwood is relying on Spartan Chassis, Inc. and the NHTSA to monitor campaign performance.
