This letter is written to notify the NHTSA that Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., is aware of the voluntary initiation of a recall notification campaign affecting Fleetwood produced recreational vehicles as listed below:

**Class C Motor Homes - Model Year 2008**

Pulse	manufactured 12/21/07 through 1/22/08
Icon	manufactured 12/21/07 through 1/22/08

This voluntary recall campaign is being conducted by:

This voluntary recall campaign involves approximately 11 Fleetwood Class C motor homes manufactured with Sprinter chassis.

Fleetwood estimates that 3% of the above motor homes contain the safety defect. This is based on the Part 573 defect report that Sprinter Engineering submitted to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration on December 21, 2007.

The reason for the recall is that on some chassis, the crankshaft sensor in certain diesel engines could fail due to separation of bond wires from the lead frame in the sensor. This results in an interruption in the electrical connection in the chip housing of the sensor. When this happens, affected vehicles may lose power rather than enter a limp-home mode. In addition, the affected vehicles cannot be restarted after failure of the electrical connection in the sensor.

Fleetwood has no reason to disagree with this action or the recall remedy. Fleetwood is relying on Sprinter Engineering and the NHTSA to monitor campaign performance.

Fleetwood has notified all Fleetwood owners of record involved in this campaign.
