In RE: 4th Quarterly Report for Fuel Pump Module Recall 07E-015

Dear Mr. Smith:

Per section 573.7, the required information is listed below.

- 1. The notification campaign number is 07E-015.
- 2. Delphi notified dealers/distributors on March 20, 2007. Delphi will mail owner notification letters if owner contact information becomes available (via dealers/distributors).
- 3. The number of fuel pump modules being recalled is 3124.
- Two vehicles have been inspected and one vehicle required a fuel pump module replacement.
- 5. Delphi estimates that 18 remaining suspect fuel pump modules of the 3124 shipped population are unreachable for inspection and replacement due to the following reasons:
 - Owner contact information is not available.
 - Non-conforming fuel pump modules were detected shortly after installation and were replaced (and scrapped) without Delphi being aware.
- 6. Delphi has inspected 2428 fuel pump modules in dealer/distributor stock and has the following breakdown:
 - 115 parts were found to be non-conforming and were replaced.
 - 2313 parts were found to be conforming and did not require replacement.
 - 29 of the 2313 were from the suspect tube bundle date code but were found to be conforming and did not require replacement.
 - Note that all inventory found is inspected regardless of the ship date.
