Dear Mr. Smith:

Per section 573.7, the required information is listed below.

- 1. The notification campaign number is 07E-021.
- 2. Delphi notified dealers/distributors on April 23, 2007. Delphi will mail owner notification letters if owner contact information becomes available (via dealers/distributors).
- 3. The number of UPRs being recalled is 742.
- 4. One vehicle has been inspected and it did not require UPR replacement.
- 5. Delphi estimates that 299 remaining suspect UPRs of the 742 shipped population are unreachable for inspection and replacement due to the following reasons:
  - Owner contact information is not available.
  - Non-conforming UPRs were detected shortly after installation and were replaced (and scrapped) without Delphi being aware.
- 6. Delphi has inspected 641 UPRs in dealer/distributor stock and has the following breakdown:
  - 41 parts were found to be from the suspect population and were replaced.
