VOLUNTARY RECALL CAMPAIGN 1997 – 2001 QX4 FUEL FILLER TUBE

INTRODUCTION

Infiniti has determined that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some 1997-2001 model year Infiniti QX4 vehicles. The fuel filler tube may have an insufficient amount of coating at the lower mounting bracket. If there is insufficient coating, corrosion may occur in geographic areas that regularly use road salt in the winter. This corrosion can result in perforation of the fuel filler tube and fuel leakage. If there is fuel leakage in the presence of an ignition source, a fire can result.

In order to prevent this potential condition, Infiniti is conducting a Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign to replace the fuel filler tube assembly in states that regularly use road salt in the winter, and to inspect and if necessary replace the fuel filler tube assembly in states that are not listed as ones that regularly use road salt in the winter.

For vehicles identified by NNA records as registered in one of the "Non-Salt States" (states not included in the list on the next page), Infiniti is advising owners of the following:

- 1. Their vehicle does not have to be repaired. However, at the owner's request their Infiniti dealer will inspect. and if necessary, replace the fuel filler tube assembly with a new one.
- 2. They should contact their dealer if they notice fuel leakage when filling the gas tank.
- 3. If their QX4 was previously registered in one of the Salt States, or it is driven there often during winter months, they may bring their vehicle to their Infiniti dealer to have the fuel filler tube inspected, and if necessary, replaced.

NUMBER OF VEHICLES POTENTIALLY AFFECTED

The number of Infiniti vehicles potentially affected is approximately 83,586

IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Infiniti has assigned identification numbers R0707 and R0708 to this campaign. R0707 or R0708 must appear on all communications and documentation of any nature dealing with this campaign. The difference between these numbers is as follows:

R0707

 This PNC group is for vehicles identified by NNA records as registered in one of the Salt States (listed below) and requires that the fuel filler tube be replaced using the Service Procedure in this bulletin.

R0708

- This PNC group is for vehicles identified by NNA records as being registered in one of the Non-Salt States.
- For vehicles identified in Infiniti Net with R0708, Infiniti is advising owners of the following:
 - 1. Their vehicle does not have to be repaired. However, at the owner's request their Infiniti dealer will inspect, and if necessary, replace the fuel filler tube assembly with a new one.
 - 2. They should contact their dealer if they notice fuel leakage when filling the gas tank.
 - If their QX4 was previously registered in one of the Salt States listed below or it is driven there often during winter months, they may bring their vehicle to their Infiniti dealer to have the fuel filler tube inspected, and if necessary, replaced.


DEALER RESPONSIBILITY

It is the dealer's responsibility to check Infiniti Net for the campaign status on each vehicle falling within the range of this voluntary safety recall which for any reason enters the service department. This includes vehicles purchased from private parties or presented by transient (tourist) owners and vehicles in a dealer's inventory. Federal law requires that new vehicles in dealer inventory which are the subject of a safety recall must be corrected prior to sale. Failure to do so can result in civil penalties by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. While federal law applies only to new vehicles, Infiniti strongly encourages dealers to correct any used vehicles in their inventory before they are retailed.

NOTE: There are two possible conditions for the application of this campaign as follows:

- 1. Salt States: Vehicles identified by NNA records as registered in one of the Salt States listed on the previous page requires that the fuel filler tube be replaced with a new one.
- 2. Non-Salt States: For vehicles identified by NNA records as registered in one of the Non-Salt States (states not included in the list on the previous page), Infiniti is advising owners of the following:
 - a. Their vehicle does not have to be repaired. However, at the owner's request their Infiniti dealer will inspect, and if necessary, replace the fuel filler tube assembly with a new one
 - b. They should contact their dealer if they notice fuel leakage when filling the gas tank.
 - c. If their QX4 was previously registered in one of the Salt States, or it is driven there often during winter months, they may bring their vehicle to their Infiniti dealer to have the fuel filler tube inspected, and if necessary, replaced.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

Fuel Filler Tube Inspection

- 1. Raise the vehicle.
- 2. Remove the left rear wheel.

3. Remove 2 clips and 1 bolt from the fuel filler tube cover.



4. Pull back the fuel filler tube cover.

- 5. Inspect the fuel filler tube in the area shown in Figure 3.
 - Use a mirror and light as needed to inspect all around the tube.
 - Inspect fuel filler tube powder coating for separation, bubbles, flaking, and/or rust corrosion.

Example of NG condition; requires replacement of the fuel filler tube.



Example of NG condition; requires replacement of the fuel filler tube.



Fuel Filler Tube Replacement

WARNING: Before stating this procedure, $\underline{\text{make sure}}$ the fuel level in the fuel tank is no more then $\frac{1}{2}$ full.

- 1. Raise the vehicle.
- 2. Remove the left rear wheel.
- 3. Remove the fuel filler tube cover; 4 clips and 2 bolts.



4. Remove the fuel filler tube mounting bolt shown in Figure A2.



5. Remove the 2 full filler mounting bolts shown in Figure A3.



6. Pull the fuel filler tube loose from the grommet at the fuel filler door and remove the tube from the wheel well.



7. Disconnect the fuel filler hose and vent hose from the fuel filler tube.



- 8. Remove the fuel filler hose and vent hose from the fuel tank.
- 9. Install the new fuel filler hose and vent hose with new clamps onto the fuel tank.
 - New hoses and clamps are included with the Filler Tube Kit listed in the Parts Information.



Remove the grommet from the fuel fill door opening.



- 11. Install the grommet on the fuel filler tube.
 - Make sure the "flap" is positioned under the lower hole (see Figure A8).



- 13. Attach the fuel filler hose and vent hose to the fuel filler tube.
 - Make sure to use new clamps included with the Filler Tube Kit.






- 14. Reinstall the fuel filler tube mounting bolts.
- 15. Reinstall the fuel fuller tube cover.
 - Use new clips and bolt included in the Filler Tube Kit.
- 16. Swap the fuel filler cap from the old fuel filler tube to the new fuel filler tube.
- 17. Reinstall the left rear wheel.
 - Torque wheel nuts to 118 147 N.m (12 15 kg-m, 87 108 ft-lb)

For vehicles, according to NNA records, that are currently registered in one of the states listed in this letter.

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Infiniti has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some 1997-2001 model year Infiniti QX4 vehicles. Our records indicate that you own or lease the Infiniti vehicle identified by the VIN on the cover of this notice.

Reason for Recall

The fuel filler tube in your QX4 may have insufficient amount of coating at the lower mounting bracket. If there is insufficient coating, corrosion may occur in geographic areas that regularly use road salt in the winter. This corrosion can result in perforation of the fuel filler tube and fuel leakage. If there is fuel leakage, in the presence of an ignition source, a fire can result.

What Infiniti Will Do

In order to prevent this from occurring, your Infiniti dealer will replace the fuel filler tube assembly with a new one with an improved coating process. This free service should take about an hour to complete, but your Infiniti dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon the dealer's work schedule.

What You Should Do

Contact your Infiniti dealer at your earliest convenience in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment. Your fuel tank should be no more than one-quarter full when you bring your vehicle to the dealer in order to minimize the possibility of fuel splfl during the repair. Instructions have been sent to your Infiniti dealer.

If you have paid to have your fuel filler tube replaced prior to this campaign, you may be eligible for reimbursement of the related expense. Also, contact your dealer if you notice fuel leakage when filling the gas tank.

What Infiniti Will Do

Because your QX4 is not registered in one of the above States, it does not have to be repaired. However, at your request, your infinition dealer will inspect, and if necessary, replace the fuel filler tube assembly with a new one with an improved coating process. This free service should take about one and a half hours to complete, but your infinition dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon the dealer's work schedule.

What You Should Do

No action is necessary because your QX4 is not registered in a State that regularly uses road salt.
