## **FOLLOW-UP NOTIFICATION**

### **SAFETY RECALL 07506**

**MARCH 2008**

Dear International® Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

This is a safety recall **follow-up** notification to the initial notice mailed in MAY 2007. International®'s records indicate the vehicle identified on the enclosed card has not yet had the recall service performed. If the recall service has been performed, please fill out and return mail the enclosed Authorization for Recall Service card so you will not be contacted again about this recall.

International® has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the Davco® Fuel Pro® 382 fuel filter of certain 7000, 8000, 9000, and ProStar® models built 12/1/2006 thru 2/21/2007.

#### **REASON FOR THIS RECALL**

When the key is in the "ON" position, the preheater located in the fuel filter base is energized. If this preheater is energized while maintenance is being performed on the fuel filter, diesel fuel could ignite within the filter housing.

#### **RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY**

A fire within the fuel filter housing may spread possibly resulting in property damage or personal injury.

#### **ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE**

Please contact your local International® dealer to schedule an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. You may locate your nearest International dealer by calling 1-800-44-TRUCK or by visiting <http://www.nav-international.com>.

The repair will involve an inspection and/or replacement of the preheater. Dealers will have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle by 5/18/2007. This repair will be performed free of charge and may take approximately 15 minutes to complete.

#### **IF YOU DO NOT OWN THIS VEHICLE**

International®'s records indicate you are the owner of the vehicle identified on the enclosed card. If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the Authorization for Recall Service card so you will not be contacted again about this recall.

#### **IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE**
