FLEETWOOD IS RECALLING 124 MY 2008-2009 JAMBOREE GT AND TIOGA SL MOTOR HOMES. THE FRONT CLEARANCE LIGHTS WIRING MAY COME IN CONTACT WITH A PORTION OF THE METAL MOUNTING PLATE AND COULD BECOME ABRADED.

**Consequence:**

THIS COULD RESULT IN A FIRE.

**Remedy:**

DEALERS WILL INSPECT THE WIRING AND REPAIR, IF NECESSARY. THE RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN ON OR ABOUT OCTOBER 3, 2008. OWNERS MAY CONTACT FLEETWOOD AT 1-800-509-3418.

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on or before 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter.
