Re: Safety Defect Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

On February 12, 2008 Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., decided that a safety defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain motor homes as listed below, and is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on February 19, 2008.
 - Fleetwood has assigned 80211 as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiaries of Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in this recall are certain 2008 model year Fiesta and Terra model motor homes manufactured between, September 28, 2007 and December 5, 2007.

The December 5, 2007 date coincides with the application of reinforcement welds to the entry step attachment cradle/support being implemented during manufacture.

These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of 793L84799199 through 794B84799320 and 793L87172711 through 794B87172997.

- (3) Fleetwood reports 50 as an approximate number of motor homes potentially containing the safety defect.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the identified motor homes potentially contain the safety defect.
- (5) On certain 2008 model year Fiesta and Terra model motor homes affected by this recall the entry step attachment cradle/support may bend as a result of step usage and insufficient structural material strength, possibly resulting in risk of personal injury, vehicle and/or other property damage.
- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in January 2008 when an incident from a recent RV show was reported to Fleetwood Motor Home Service. The incident involved an individual stepping onto a Fiesta/Terra motor home entry step, at which point the entry step cradle/support bent, causing the step to become unstable.


Fleetwood is not aware of any accidents or injuries that have resulted from this safety defect.

- (8) Fleetwood will inspect and if necessary, reinforce the entry step attachment cradle/support.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification on March 10, 2008.
Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification mailing on March 17, 2008.
- (10) Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.
- (11) Copies of subsequent correspondence will be submitted to the NHTSA within five (5) working days of distribution. This correspondence will include:
 - I) Letter of dealer notification
 - II) Letter of customer notification
 - III) Service Bulletin

Drafts of the service bulletin and letters to dealers and owners will be forthcoming for your review.
