Re: Non-Compliance Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

On March 10, 2008 Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., decided that a non-compliance to the requirements of Part 567 "Certification" exists in motor homes as listed below, and is furnishing this notification in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-Compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on March 14, 2008.
 - Fleetwood has assigned 80310 as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiaries of Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in the recall are 2008 and 2009 model year Pulse and Icon, Class C motor homes manufactured from October 26, 2007 through February 29, 2008. The February 29, 2008 date coincides with correct front Gross Axle Weight Rating Federal Certification and Cargo Carrying Capacity tags being applied to the motor homes during production.

These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of:
765D84798976 through 765D94799805
765D87172452 through 766D87172452

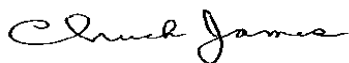
- (3) Fleetwood reports approximately 166 as the number of Pulse and Icon, Class C motor homes containing the non-compliance.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the affected Pulse and Icon, Class C motor homes contain the non-compliance.
- (5) On Pulse and Icon, Class C motor homes affected by this recall, the Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and the Cargo Carrying Capacity tag figure related to the Front Gross Axle Weight Rating of 4,080 pounds is incorrect. The correct Front Gross Axle Weight Rating is 4,410 pounds.
- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in March, 2008 when the Fleetwood Product Development group discovered the error.
- (8) Fleetwood will mail correct Manufacturer Federal Certification and Cargo Carrying Capacity tags to dealers and owner's of record and will ask that they deface the original Manufacturer Federal Certification and Cargo Carrying Capacity tags and replace them with the new, serial number specific Manufacturer Federal Certification and Cargo Carrying Capacity tags. Owners who are not comfortable installing these labels will be asked to contact their selling dealer to have this service performed at no charge.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification by e-mail on March 24, 2008.
Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification, by UPS traceable, on March 31, 2008.

Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.

- (10) Copies of subsequent correspondence will be submitted to the NHTSA within five (5) working days of distribution. This correspondence will include:
 - I) Letter of dealer notification
 - II) Letter of customer notification
 - III) Service Bulletin
