Dear Associate Administrator:

Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Monaco Coach Corporation ("Monaco" or the "Company") is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a safety recall that was previously filed on April 15, 2008 with the following amendments:

573.6(c)(2)

The affected vehicles include the following Class A motorhomes with the inverter option:

Monaco: 2007 Monarch (56), 2007-2008 Lapalma Rear Gas (5) and 2007-2008 Lapalma Diesel (235)

Holiday Rambler: 2007 Admiral (91), 2008 Vacationer Rear Gas (6) and 2007-2008 Vacationer Diesel (220)

Safari: 2007 Simba (35)

The affected motorhomes were manufactured from March 23, 2006 through April 1, 2008.

573.6(c)(3)

A total of **eight hundred and fourteen (814)** Class A motorhomes are in the recall population. Of this total, **six hundred and forty eight (648)** are in the United States and **one hundred and sixty six (166)** were exported.

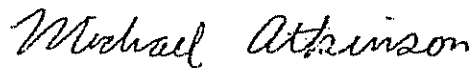

Monaco has determined that all of the motorhomes in this recall population need to have the repair performed and none have been repaired to date.

The recall population will be determined from the manufacturing records for the Company's manufacturing facility in Wakarusa, Indiana and Coburg, Oregon which produced the affected motorhomes.

Copies of the drafts of owner and dealer notification letters will be supplied in the future for your approval. Repair instructions and final owner and dealer notification letters will be provided pending approval and recall number. The Company expects owner and dealer notification to begin in early August 2008.
