Defect and Non-Compliance Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

Damon has identified vehicle non-compliance in certain Damon motorhomes manufactured between August 2006 and May 2008.

Pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, we are hereby notifying the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration that certain vehicles manufactured by Damon were built with incorrect air pressure ratings on the Federal Certification Label.

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The motorhomes built with the non-compliance are as follows:

Intruder	373, 374, 378	2007
Outlaw	3611	2007, 2008, 2009
Challenger	371, 376, 377, 378	2009

The total number of vehicles subject to this recall campaign is 265.

- B. Description of Defect. The recall affects motorhomes that were built on 2006 and 2007 Ford chassis with a 22,000 lbs. GVWR and 22.5" tires. The metric and English values for the tire air pressures were inadvertently switched. The labels read 90KPA / 620PSI and they should read 620KPA / 90PSI. 100% of the motorhomes subject to this recall campaign have the tire pressure information reversed.
- C. Basis for Determining that a Defect Exists. Damon discovered this non-compliance during a routine audit. There are no known injuries or accidents that have been reported to Damon as a result of this non-compliance.

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- D. Remedying of Defect. The recall campaign to be implemented by Damon to remedy the non-compliance will be to send a revised certification label with the correct tire pressure values to the affected customers with instructions for installation. This will be done at no charge to the affected customers.
- E. Owner Notifications. Damon will notify owners of the motorhomes of the non-compliance. A copy of the Owner's notification letter will be forwarded shortly for approval.
- F. Quarterly Reporting Requirements. Damon will be filing quarterly reports as required by Part 573.7 of Title 49 the Code of Federal Regulations.
- G. Campaign Number. Damon's internal number for this recall is 08-124.

The enclosed information should comply with the NHTSA regulations and satisfy the obligations of Damon with respect to this recall campaign.
