Re: Non-Compliance Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

On June 23, 2008 Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., decided that a non-compliance to the requirements of Part 567 "Certification" exists in motor homes as listed below, and is furnishing this notification in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-Compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on June 26, 2008.
 - Fleetwood has assigned 80624 as an identification code to this recall.

- (2) The vehicles involved in the recall are 2008 and 2009 model year American Allegiance, American Eagle, American Heritage, American Tradition, Revolution LE, Bounder, Bounder Diesel,

Discovery, Excursion, Expedition, Providence, Pace Arrow, Southwind, and Fiesta LX Class A motor homes. Pulse, Icon, Jamboree, Jamboree GT, Jamboree Sport, Tioga and Tioga Ranger Class C motor homes manufactured from May 19, 2008 through June 20, 2008. The June 20, 2008 date coincides with corrected Occupant Cargo Carrying Capacity (OCCC) Federal Certification tags being applied to the motor homes during production.

- (3) Fleetwood reports approximately 226 as the number of motor homes containing the non-compliance.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the affected motor homes contain the non-compliance.
- (5) On motor homes affected by this recall, the Manufacturer Federal Certification tag figures related to the Occupant and Cargo Carrying Capacity (OCCC) were calculated incorrectly allowing additional load carrying capacity. Overloading may have an adverse affect on motor home handling.
- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in June, 2008 when during an internal audit of the new Federal Certification tag, a plant associate noticed the calculation error.
- (8) Fleetwood will mail corrected Manufacturer Federal Certification tags to dealers and owner's of record and will ask that they deface the original Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and replace it with the new, serial number specific Manufacturer Federal Certification tag. Owners who are not comfortable installing this label will be asked to contact their selling dealer to have this service performed at no charge.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification by e-mail on July 3, 2008.

Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification, by UPS traceable, on July 8, 2008.

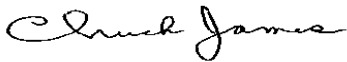
Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.
