

DEFECT INFORMATION REPORT FOR RECALL #08E-032

[a follow-up to Recall #06E-076]

1. Manufacturer's name/address: The manufacturer of the vehicles covered by this report is: Jensen Enterprises Ltd., dba Jensen Trailers, 811 North 13th St, Humboldt, IA 50548
2. Vehicles involved: The vehicles covered by this report are recreational vehicles that were equipped with certain models of refrigerators manufactured by Dometic, LLC, between June 2003 and September 2006. The vehicle models in question are: Jensen custom built truck bodies, which were manufactured during the period from June 2003 through September 2006 [expanded period].
3. Total number of vehicles: The total number of vehicles covered by this report is: 2 [two].

4. Approximate percentage of vehicles estimated to actually contain the defect: Based on information received from Dometic, Jensen Trailers believes that approximately .005 percent of these vehicles actually contain the defect.
5. Description of the defect: Under some circumstances, a fatigue crack can develop in the boiler tube of the covered refrigerators, which can permit the release of pressurized coolant solution. If this solution is exposed to an ignition source under certain specific circumstances, it can result in a vehicle fire.
6. Chronological summary of events leading to this determination: Dometic advised Jensen Trailers of its defect determination by notification from Stericycle [note: extended coverage period]. Jensen Trailers is NOT aware of any fires in its vehicles that appear to be related to this defect. Nevertheless, after reviewing the matter, Jensen Trailers decided to submit this defect report.
7. Program for remedying the defect: Dometic has arranged to conduct a recall to remedy the potential defect in Jensen Trailers' vehicles at no charge to vehicle owners. See Recall #08E-032. Pursuant to 49 CFR 573.60(8)(i) and 573.13, owners will be advised that Dometic will reimburse them if they have incurred costs to obtain a remedy for a refrigerator containing such a defect prior to their receipt of the notification. Jensen Trailers recognizes that as a final stage vehicle manufacturer, it remains responsible for the successful completion of the recall campaign.

Dear Jensen Trailer owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirement of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Jensen Trailers, in conjunction with Dometic Corporation, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2003 – 2006 specialty vehicles equipped with refrigerators manufactured by Dometic.

PROBLEM DESCRIPTION AND CONSEQUENCES: After some period of use, a fatigue crack may develop in the boiler tube of the covered refrigerators that may release a sufficient amount of pressurized coolant solution into an area where an ignition source may be present. If this were to occur under certain conditions, the coolant could ignite and result in a fire.

WHAT DOMETIC WILL DO: Dometic will provide owners of all covered refrigerators a rework for the potential defect at no charge for parts or labor. The rework involves the installation of a secondary burner housing, and certain fuses that will prevent this condition from leading to a fire outside the burner area. The kit was created with ease of installation in mind, and a thorough installation guide, including photos, is included in every individual packet. All parts are included in the kit, and no unusual tools are necessary.


WHAT YOU SHOULD DO: Call your local RV servicing dealer for an appointment to have Dometic's recall kit installed on your refrigerator. The parts are now available from Dometic, and your local RV servicing dealer is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure that your vehicle is corrected as promptly as possible. If you, however, take your vehicle to your dealer on the agreed service date, and they do not remedy this condition on that date or within three (3) days, we recommend you contact the Dometic customer service department by calling 1-888-446-5157.

After contacting your dealer and the Dometic customer service, if you are still not able to have the safety defect remedied without charge and within a reasonable time, you may wish to write the Administer, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 400 Seventh Street SW, Washington, DC 20590, or via their website, www.safercars.gov, or call the Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 800-424-9153).

We are sorry to cause this inconvenience; however, we have taken this action in the interest of your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.
