1. Manufacturer's name /address:

2. Vehicles Involved:

The vehicles covered by this report are recreational vehicles that were equipped with certain models of refrigerators manufactured by Dometic, LLC between June 1, 2003 and September 30, 2006. This is an expansion of Dometic's previous recall, announced in August of 2006. The vehicles make and model years in question are as follows:

Nu Wa Champagne Edition 2004 - 2007
Nu Wa Discovery Series 2004 - 2007
Nu Wa Premier 2004 - 2006
Nu Wa Snowbird SnowVilla 2004
Custom Campers HH II 2004
Custom Campers LS 2004 - 2007
Custom Campers Snowbird SE 2004

The vehicles were manufactured during the period from June 1, 2003 through September 2006. The September 2006 date may be extended after the total production amounts become available.

3. Total number of vehicles:

The total number of vehicles covered by this report is unknown at this time. Total amount of production with a potential safety related defective will not be available until July 21, 2008.

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4. Approximate percentage of vehicles estimated to actually contain the defect:

Based on information received from Demetic, Nu Wa Industries Inc. believes that approximately .005 percent of these vehicles actually contain the defect.

5. Description of the defect:

Under some circumstances, a fatigue crack can develop in the boiler tube of the covered refrigerators, which can permit the release of pressurized coolant solution. If this solution is exposed to an ignition source under certain specific circumstances, it can result in a vehicle fire.

6. Chronological summary of events leading to this determination:

Demetic advised Nu Wa Industries Inc. of its defect determination by letter which was received on June 20, 2008. Nu Wa is not aware of any fires in its vehicles built during the expansion time period that appear to be related to this defect. Nevertheless, after reviewing the matter Nu Wa has decided to submit this defect report.

7. Program for remedying the defect:

Dometic has arranged to conduct a recall to remedy the potential defect in Nu Wa Industries and its subsidiary Custom Campers vehicles at no charge to vehicle owners. See Recall No.08E-032. Pursuant to 49 CFR 573.6(c) (8) (i) and 573.13, owners will be advised that Dometic will reimburse them if they have incurred costs to obtain a remedy for a refrigerator containing such a defect prior to their receipt of the notification.
