Defect and Non-Compliance Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

Thor America has been notified by Dometic concerning a safety related defect in certain two-door refrigerators manufactured between June 1, 2003 and September 30, 2006. Dometic has already initiated a safety recall campaign with respect to this non-compliance. NHTSA has assigned recall number 08E-032 to the Dometic recall campaign.

Pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, we are hereby notifying the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration that certain vehicles manufactured by Thor America were built with Dometic refrigerators that may contain the safety related defect.

As more specifically set forth below, Dometic has agreed to conduct the recall campaign involving the defective refrigerators. Thor America will provide Dometic with a list of dealers and owners to assist Dometic in remedying the defect. Dometic will be filing the quarterly reports in connection with the recall campaign.

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The defective refrigerators supplied by Dometic have been used on the following travel trailers:

<u>Model</u>	<u>Years Affected</u>
Citation	2003, 2004, 2005
Chateau	2003, 2004, 2005
Corsair	2003, 2004, 2005

These travel trailers were manufactured between June 2003 and April 2005. The total number of travel trailers subject to this recall campaign is approximately 2,700. A vehicle registration search will be conducted to determine the exact number of trailers involved in this recall.

- B. Description of Defect. Under some circumstances, a fatigue crack can develop in the boiler tube of the covered refrigerators, which can permit the release of pressurized coolant solution. If this solution is exposed to an ignition source under certain specific circumstances, it can result in a vehicle fire.

- C. Basis for Determining that a Defect Exists. Dometic advised Thor America of its defect determination by letter on June 20, 2008.
- D. Remedying of Defect. As set forth in the notification issued by Dometic in connection with recall campaign 08E-032, Dometic will remedy the refrigerator if found to be defective. The owners of the vehicles subject to this recall campaign will be advised to contact Dometic in order to make arrangements to have the remedy completed by Dometic. Dometic will implement the recall campaign in accordance with the procedures specified in recall campaign 08E-032. Dometic has agreed to remedy the defect without charge to the owners.
- E. Owner Notifications. Thor America will work with Dometic to notify the owner's of the recalled vehicles. This notification will occur once the vehicle registration search has been completed. In the meantime, any owner of a Thor America product may contact Dometic directly at 1-888-446-5157 to start the recall process on their vehicle. A copy of the owner's letter will be forwarded to NHTSA when available for approval.
- F. Dealer Notifications. Thor America will work with Dometic to notify its dealers of the recalled vehicles. A copy of the dealer's letter will be forwarded shortly for approval.
- G. Quarterly Reporting Requirements. Dometic will be responsible for filing quarterly reports in connection with recall campaign 08E-032. Because the information included by Dometic in its quarterly reports will encompass the remedying of the Thor America vehicles subject to this recall campaign, Thor America will not file quarterly reports to avoid duplication.
- H. Campaign Number. Thor America does not have an internal campaign number for this recall. Thor America will use the recall campaign number assigned by NHTSA.

The enclosed information should comply with the NHTSA regulations and satisfy the obligations of Thor America with respect to this recall campaign.
