On July 9, 2008, Caterpillar notified GM of a safety defect that may exist with Fuel Pumps used on Caterpillar C7 and C9 Diesel Engines, NHTSA 08E-042.

The issue was presented to the Field Performance Evaluation Review Committee and on July 17, 2008, the Executive Field Action Decision Committee concurred for Caterpillar to conduct a safety recall.

GM is relying on Caterpillar to monitor campaign performance.

GM has furnished VIN information requested by Caterpillar and Caterpillar is conducting the recall.
