Dear Mr. Smith:

The following information is submitted pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6 as it applies to a determination by General Motors of a noncompliance involving certain 2006-08 model year Chevrolet HHR vehicles.

573.6(c)(1): Chevrolet Brand of General Motors Corporation

573.6(c)(2)(3)(4): This information is shown on the attached sheet.

<u>573.6(c)(5)</u>: General Motors has decided that certain 2006-08 model year Chevrolet HHR vehicles fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 201, "Occupant Protection in Interior Impact." In tests, the door on the storage bin in the top center of the instrument panel failed to remain closed as required.

573.6(c)(7): GM's determination is based on:

On April 2, 2008, a NHTSA contractor tested a 2007 Chevrolet HHR. The door on the storage bin in the top center of the instrument panel failed to remain closed as required.

The issue was presented to the Field Performance Evaluation Review Committee and on August 28, 2008, the Executive Field Action Decision Committee decided to conduct a noncompliance recall.

573.6(c)(8): GM will mail to customers a latch reinforcement. Owners will be given instructions to install the part or have their dealer install it.

Pursuant to 577.11(e), GM does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because this remedy was not previously known to or available from dealers or other service providers.

573.6(c)(9): GM will provide copies of the dealer bulletin and owner letter when available. Based on expected parts availability, GM anticipates sending the dealer bulletin and owner letters in late November 2008.
