Dear Associate Administrator:

Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573, Monaco Coach Corporation ("Monaco" or the "Company") is submitting this report to NHTSA concerning a safety recall that was previously filed on August 29, 2008 with the following amendments:

573.5(c)(2)

The affected vehicles include the following Class A motorhomes equipped with C7 or C9 Caterpillar engines:

Safari: 2008-2009 Cheetah (44)

Beaver: 2008-2009 Contessa (152) and 2009 Monterey (21)


The affected motorhomes were manufactured from August 17, 2007 through August 26, 2008.

The 2008-2009 Safari Cascade RD and 2008 Monterey models are not affected as previously reported.

573.5(c)(3)

A total of **two hundred and sixty-four (264)** C7 and C9 engines purchased by Monaco from Caterpillar are in the recall population. Of this total, **two hundred and thirty-eight (238)** are in the United States and **twenty-six (26)** were exported. Of the engines that are in the United States, **two hundred and seventeen (217)** were installed in motorhomes, **twenty (20)** remain in Monaco's inventory and have not been installed in chassis, and **one (1)** was returned to Caterpillar as defective.
