Sundowner trailer has determined that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists with the wiring harness on a limited number of Sunlite Living Quarter Trailers.

The suspect trailers include Sunlite LQ Models; 575 gn, 700 gn, 705 gn, 720 gn, 725 gn, 727 gn, 737, 740, 760, 777 gn, Cargo gn, Stock gn, ProStock gn, and StampedeSL gn. Total number of trailers involved are 4,535.

The individual trailers we are concerned with are not equipped with a fuse in line with the wire harness that connects to the tow vehicle. We have determined that if an improperly wired tow vehicle is connected to the trailer wiring harness there is a possibility of electrical short which could cause a fire resulting in property damage or injury to consumer and/or livestock.

I am attaching to this letter a copy of the recall packet that we will be sending to all owners of the identified units. These recall packets will be sent by registered mail. Sundowner Trailers, Inc. will also contact all our dealerships involved, notifying them of the recall. Sundowner Trailers, Inc. will also provide the dealerships with the information needed to refit those units with an adequate fuse link and rewire instructions. Sundowner Trailers, Inc. will begin it's mail out of recall notices on or before October 20th 2008 to be completed October 30th 2008. On or before that same date Sundowner Trailers, Inc. will also contact all dealerships involved with their notification.

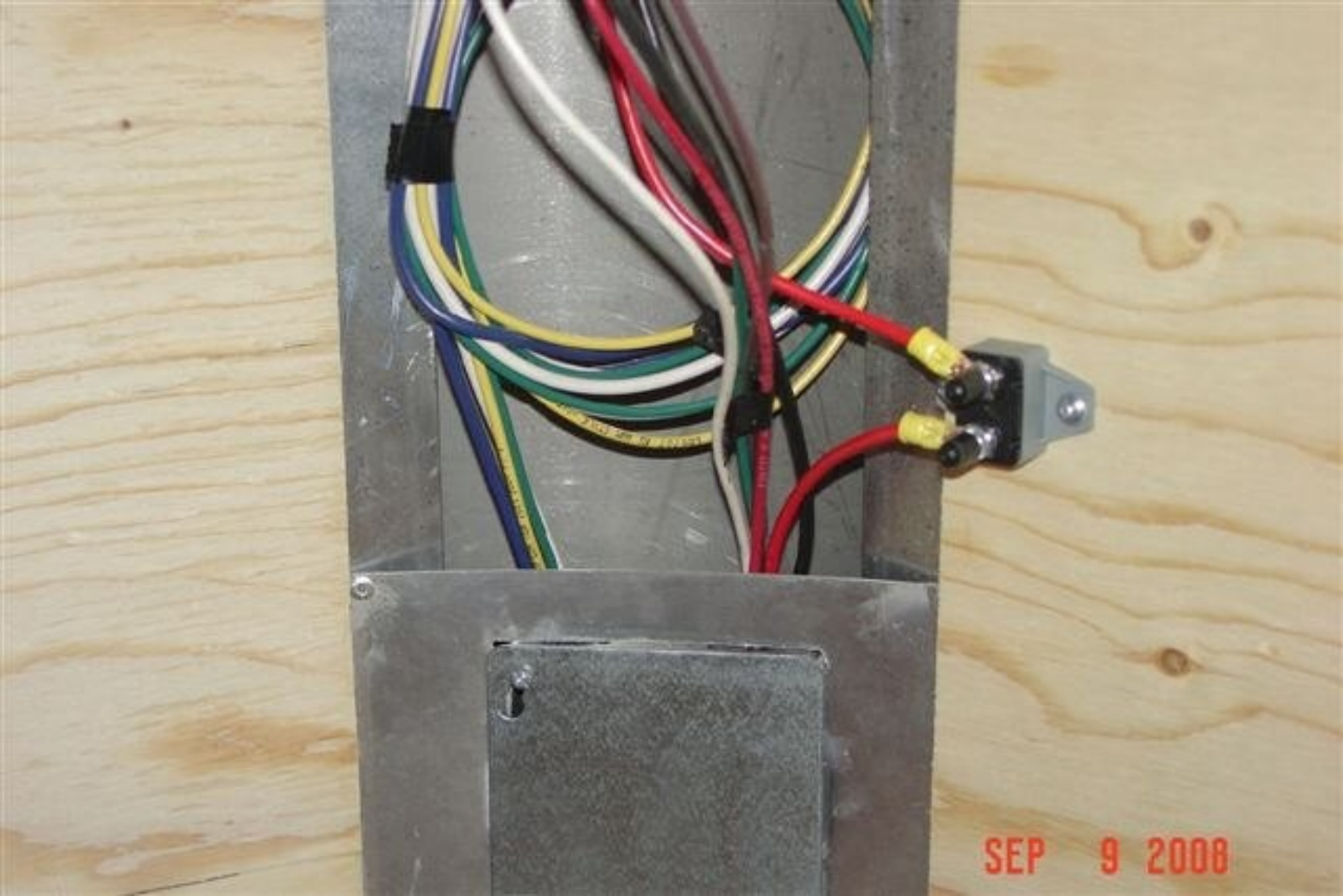
The individual trailers we are concerned with are not equipped with a fuse in line with the wire harness that connects to the tow vehicle. We have determined that if an improperly wired tow vehicle is connected to the trailer wiring harness there is a possibility of electrical short which could cause a fire resulting in property damage or injury to you and/or your stock.

We are notifying customers who have the identified trailers with the information of the nonconformity. We are also supplying them with our Corporate 800 number so they can call us. When they call us we will direct them to their nearest dealership, that dealership will be notified at the same time so they can be prepared for the customer. Sundowner will supply the dealership involved with the customer name and phone number. Because this is a safety related issue we request that you schedule them in as soon as possible.

The customer will not be charged for anything related to the refitting.

Sundowner will reimburse the dealership for the cost of repair. Repair time will be 1 hour @ standard labor rate plus cost of fuse and wire and clips.
