Re: Safety Defect / Non-Compliance Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

On September 17, 2008, Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., decided that a non-compliance to the requirements of Part 567 "Certification" exists in motor homes as listed below, and is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on September 24, 2008.
 - Fleetwood has assigned 80911 as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiary of Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in the recall are certain 2008 and 2009 model year American Allegiance, American Eagle, American Heritage, American Tradition and Revolution L.E. model motor homes manufactured from:

American Allegiance - May 28, 2008 through August 20, 2008
American Eagle - May 28, 2008 through June 11, 2008

American Heritage - June 12, 2008 through August 28, 2008
American Tradition - May 19, 2008 through July 29, 2008
Revolution L.E. - June 3, 2008 through July 28, 2008

The August 28, 2008 date coincides with correct rear and intermediate tire pressure rating, Federal Certification tags being applied to the motor homes during production.

These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of:

American Allegiance -	771G94403464 through 771G94403662
American Eagle -	719C84403468 through 719P94403516
American Heritage -	782B94403236 through 782B94403434
American Tradition -	780C94403386 through 780P94403651
Revolution L.E. -	781K84403472 through 781N94403626

- (3) Fleetwood reports approximately 65 as the number of American Allegiance, American Eagle, American Heritage, American Tradition and Revolution L.E. model motor homes that contain the non-compliance.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the affected American Allegiance, American Eagle, American Heritage, American Tradition and Revolution L.E. model motor homes contain the non-compliance.
- (5) On certain 2008 and 2009 American Allegiance, American Eagle, American Heritage, American Tradition and Revolution L.E. model motor homes affected by this recall, the Manufacturer Federal Certification tag figures related to the rear and intermediate tire pressure rating (PSI) are reversed. Please Note: all other values are correct.

A misprinted label could lead to improper vehicle loading or tire inflation which could result in tire failure, increasing the risk of a crash.

- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in September 2008 after a Fleetwood Engineering Technician discovered the error.

Fleetwood is not aware of any accidents or injuries that have resulted from this safety defect.

- (8) Fleetwood will mail corrected Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification tags to dealers and owner's or record and will ask that they deface the original Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification tag. Dealers and owners of record will be asked to check and if necessary adjust tire pressure to the correct PSI. Owner's who are not comfortable installing this label or checking tire pressures will be asked to contact their selling dealer to have this service performed at no charge.

- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification by e-mail on October 8, 2008.

Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification by UPS traceable on October 15, 2008.

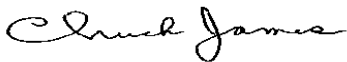
Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.
