 07E-097 / Adjust sensitivity of the anti-stow pressure switch mounted on the hydraulic pump to a position that causes the platform to exhibit 5-6 pulses during the stowing cycle. A pulse is characterized by a momentary hesitation in movement of the platform. Lifts subject to this recall will exhibit 1-2 pulses only.

Clearly describe the distinguishing characteristics of the remedy component/assembly versus the recalled component/assembly

07E-097 / Not applicable, no parts are required.
