REPORT TO NHTSA

1. Manufacturer's Name: Wilson Trailer Company
2. Vehicle Identification: 2009 Wilson Grain Trailers manufactured from 9/22/08 to 10/24/08
3. Total Number of Vehicles Subject to Recall: 238
4. Percentage of Trailer Estimated to be Defective: 3 trailers 2%
5. Description of Defect: The defect concerns the pivot bolts in the suspension hangers. The pivot bolts were loosened at installation and were not properly re-torqued. If the fasteners are loose, this could result in premature bushing or hanger wear or loss of axle attachment.
6. History of Events: 3 trailers manufactured within said time frame have experienced loose pivot bolts on the suspension hangers due to failure to properly torque the same.
7. Description of Remedy: Check the pivot bolts on the suspension hangers for torque and tighten to 475 foot pounds, if necessary.
