Dear NABI Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. NABI (North American Bus Industries, Inc.), in conjunction with Hübner Manufacturing, has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain transit buses manufactured between August 2006 and April 2007. The affected buses are equipped with a Hübner Manufacturing articulation join.

Our records identify you as the owner of the vehicle(s) affected by this recall. (Please see attached VIN listing of affected vehicles.)

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Certain Hübner articulation joints have potentially defective castings. If the casting fractures, loss of vehicle control could occur, increasing the risk of a crash.

NABI will coordinate with Hübner to ensure these suspect castings are replaced free-of-charge.

ACTION YOU SHOULD TAKE

Once material is available, NABI will be contacting you to coordinate replacement. This material should be available in the first calendar quarter of 2008.

In the abundance of caution, until the casting has been replaced, NABI and Hübner strongly recommend that the castings continue to be inspected at the normal inspection interval, or 6,000 miles, whichever is less.

You may also wish to submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE, Room W46-425, Washington D.C. 20590, or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hot-line at 888.327.4236 (TTY: 800.424.9153) if you believe that NABI has failed to remedy the vehicle without charge, within a reasonable time, which is no longer than 60 days after your first tender to obtain repair. You may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of a problem associated with this recall. Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
