**SAFETY RECALL NOTICE**

**Dear NABI Customer:**

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. NABI (North American Bus Industries, Inc.) has decided a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain transit buses manufactured between March 2006 and September 2006. The affected buses are equipped with a Cummins engine.

Our records identify you as the owner of the vehicle(s) affected by this recall. (Please see attached VIN listing of affected vehicles.)

**REASON FOR THIS RECALL**

Vehicles with affected Cummins engines have a potentially defective fuel line. If the fuel line cracks, fuel could leak or spray into the engine compartment area, increasing the risk of a fire.

This fuel line will be replaced and/or supported free-of-charge by your local authorized Cummins dealer.

**ACTION YOU SHOULD TAKE**

Contact your local Cummins Authorized repair facility to schedule repairs pursuant to Cummins bulletin C0610 replacement of the suspect fuel line.

You may also wish to submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue, SE., Washington, DC 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov> if you believe that Cummins or NABI has failed to remedy the vehicle without charge, within a reasonable time, which is no longer than 60 days after your first tender to obtain repair. You may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of a problem associated with this recall. Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
