**RE: Safety Recall Action J007 – Rear Seat Belt D-rings
Vehicles Affected: 2009 XF**

Dear Jaguar XF Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Jaguar has decided that a defect, relating to motor vehicle safety, exists in some 2009 model year XF vehicles. Your vehicle is included in this recall action.

What is the concern?

Affected vehicles may have a rear seat belt D-ring that does not rotate freely. The seat belt may not run freely when the rear seat belts are being pulled out and, should a vehicle suffer a moderate to heavy frontal impact, the rear seat occupants may not be fully restrained, increasing the risk of injury to the front and rear seat occupants.

What will Jaguar and your Jaguar Dealer do?

An authorized Jaguar Dealer will inspect both the left and right-hand rear seat belt D-rings to ensure both rotate freely.

What should you do?

Please contact your authorized Jaguar Dealer at your earliest convenience to schedule an appointment to have Recall Action J007 completed on your vehicle.

How long will it take?

Repair time is estimated to be less than an hour to inspect and, if necessary, repair the rear seat belt D-ring. Because of Dealer scheduling requirements, your vehicle may be needed for a longer period of time.

Attention Leasing Agencies:

Federal regulations require that you forward this recall notification to the lessee within TEN days.

If you are no longer the owner of this vehicle, Jaguar would greatly appreciate the name and address of the new owner, using the enclosed return postage-paid card.
