This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

A.T.T.P., LLC has decided that certain Ford Econoline wheelchair vans equipped with Ricon S-Series wheelchair lifts fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 404, "Platform Lift Installations in Motor Vehicles". The Threshold Warning System may not detect the presence of a wheelchair or mobility aid user in a certain spot within the defined threshold area. In the event this condition occurs during passenger operations the wheelchair or mobility aid, user may move toward the vehicle lift door when the lift platform is below floor level. This situation could cause personal injury.

WHAT WE WILL DO

Upon notification, Ricon will provide you or the A.T.T.P., LLC. the replacement parts kit. We will provide all the necessary adjustment instructions and/or replacement parts Free of Charge.
