SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

Item 4 (b): Vehicles Eligible for Remedy

Daihatsu Motor Co., Ltd. has voluntarily agreed that all 1990 to 1992 Rocky vehicles located within the United States will be eligible for and included in this Campaign, # 10V-083, even if first sold outside the USA. All vehicles submitted for repair under this Campaign will have the old check valve replaced with a new check valve of improved construction, at no charge to the owner. Therefore the number of vehicles physically inspected and not receiving the remedy will always be zero (0).

There is no way to estimate whether the condition will affect all Rocky vehicles equally, or whether some may not be affected by age and deterioration. Thus, all Rockys will be recalled, repaired and provided with the improved part without exception. Because Daihatsu no longer has a retail sales or service organization in the United States, it is unlikely that any vehicle would be inspected unless the owner is responding to the recall campaign.

Item 5: Vehicles Determined to be Unreachable:

Data reported here is taken from information received by return mail from Registered Owners or former owners of vehicles included in state DMV records. The recall campaign notification package includes a business reply card for ex-owners to return, reporting on their disposition of a given vehicle (by vehicle identification number). Neither Daihatsu nor R.L. Polk, the mailing agent for this Campaign, has made a separate factual determination of disposition other than as received from the former owner of record.
