**Summary:**

KEYSTONE IS RECALLING 44 MY 2009 FUZION FIFTH WHEEL TRAILERS FOR FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF PART 567, "CERTIFICATION." THE FEDERAL IDENTIFICATION LABEL AND TIRE LOADING INFORMATION LABEL DOES NOT CONTAIN THE CORRECT TIRE INFLATION PRESSURE.

**Consequence:**

IMPROPER TIRE PRESSURE CAN LEAD TO TIRE FAILURE AND AN INCREASED RISK OF PROPERTY DAMAGE.

**Remedy:**

DEALERS WILL MAIL THE APPROPRIATE LABELS FREE OF CHARGE. IF THE CUSTOMER REQUIRES ASSISTANCE INSTALLING THE LABELS, A DEALER WILL INSTALL THE LABEL. THE RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN ON OR BEFORE JUNE 12, 2009. OWNERS MAY CONTACT KEYSTONE RV AT 1-866-425-4369.
