Re: Non-Compliance Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

On March 5, 2009 Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., decided that a non-compliance to the requirements of Part 567 "Certification" exists in motor homes as listed below, and is furnishing this notification in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-Compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on March 10, 2009.
 - Fleetwood has assigned 90305 as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiaries of Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in the recall are 2009 model year Tioga and Jamboree 31M model class C motor homes manufactured from June 3, 2008 through January 21, 2009. The January 21, 2009 date coincides with corrected Federal Certification and Cargo Carrying Capacity tags being applied to the motor homes during production.

These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of:

751M94700507 through 751M94701272
751M97173961 through 751M97174465
741M94700429 through 741M94701275
741M97173964 through 741M97174464

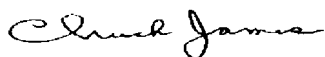
- (3) Fleetwood reports approximately 124 as the number of Tioga and Jamboree 31M model class C motor homes containing the non-compliance.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the affected motor homes contain the non-compliance.
- (5) On motor homes affected by this recall, the Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and the Cargo Carrying Capacity tag figures related to the fresh water tank capacity of 50 gallons is incorrect. The correct water tank capacity is 35 gallons.
- (6) Not applicable
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in February, 2009 when a retail customer reported the error.
- (8) Fleetwood will mail correct Manufacturer Federal Certification and Cargo Carrying Capacity tags to dealers and owner's of record and will ask that they deface the original Manufacturer Federal Certification and Cargo Carrying Capacity tags and replace them with the new, serial number specific tags. Owners who are not comfortable installing these labels will be asked to contact their selling dealer to have this service performed at no charge.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification by e-mail in April, 2009.
Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification, by UPS traceable, in April, 2009.

Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.

- (10) Copies of subsequent correspondence will be submitted to the NHTSA within five (5) working days of distribution. This correspondence will include:
 - I) Letter if dealer notification
 - II) Letter of customer notification
 - III) Service Bulletin

IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION #90305

Dear Valued Fleetwood Motor Home Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., on behalf of its subsidiary manufacturing centers located in Riverside, California and Paxinos, Pennsylvania has decided that certain 2009 model year Tioga and Jamboree 31M model class C motor homes fail to comply with the requirements of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 567, "Certification".

WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., has become aware of a fresh water tank capacity input error. The Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and the Cargo Carrying Capacity tag were printed with an incorrect fresh water tank capacity of 50 gallons. The correct fresh water tank capacity is 35 gallons.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

Deface the original Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and Cargo Carrying Capacity tag and replace them with the new serial number specific Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and Cargo Carrying Capacity tag that are enclosed with this letter. You can locate the Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and the Cargo Carrying Capacity tag on the inside sidewall just behind the driver's seat. **Note: Please peel the backing before applying over the defaced originals.**

After you have completed this procedure, please return the enclosed self-addressed **Vehicle Information Update Card** to Fleetwood.

If you do not feel comfortable installing these tags, you may take your motor home to any Fleetwood dealer and they will perform this service at no charge to you.

When you deliver your motor home for repairs, your dealer will complete a **Fleetwood Repair Order**. Upon completion of the repair, please sign the dealership's Repair Order or Fleetwood's Repair Order and fill out the enclosed self-addressed **Vehicle Information Update Card** and return it to Fleetwood.

If you have changed your address or sold the motor home, please take a moment to provide the name and address of the person or dealership you sold it to on the enclosed

Vehicle Information Update Card and return it to Fleetwood. This will allow us to update our records and if necessary, notify the new owner using the information you provide.

If you have had this concern corrected previously, you may be eligible for reimbursement of your cost for that repair. For more information regarding this recall #90305, contact Fleetwood Owner Relations at 800-509-3418.

For leased vehicles: Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

CAPACITY**

Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., on behalf of its subsidiary manufacturing centers located in Riverside, California and Paxinos, Pennsylvania is requesting your assistance in conducting a voluntary recall notification campaign in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc. has decided that certain 2009 Tioga and Jamboree 31M model class C motor homes fail to comply with the Code of Federal Regulation Part 567 "Certification". These motor homes were manufactured at our Riverside, California and Paxinos, Pennsylvania manufacturing plants from June 3, 2008 through January 21, 2009.

We are notifying the owners of the affected units in order to correct the problem. A copy of the letter sent to owners is enclosed for your information.

WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., has become aware of a fresh water tank capacity input error. The Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and the Cargo Carrying Capacity tag were printed with an incorrect fresh water tank capacity of 50 gallons. The correct fresh water tank capacity is 35 gallons.

To correct this non-compliance, it is necessary to replace the Manufacturer Federal Certification tag and the Cargo Carrying Capacity tag as described in the enclosed Recall Service Bulletin #90305.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

Please check your motor home inventory and perform the repair procedure on affected units as outlined in the attached Service Bulletin #90305. It is imperative that this procedure be completed prior to the sale of the affected units so your customers will not be inconvenienced.

Owners of the above mentioned motor homes have been asked to contact their Fleetwood dealer to have the described non-compliance remedied. In the event that a customer contacts you, please verify eligibility by referring to the serial number range listed in the enclosed Recall Service Bulletin #90305 prior to beginning the inspection and repairs.

Once repairs are completed, have the customer sign your dealership's Internal Repair Order and submit your request electronically through e-FDN, or you may also have the customer sign the Fleetwood Repair Order (form X-SR-042) and submit for reimbursement in accordance with Service Bulletin #90305. Customers will not be charged for these repairs.

If you have one of these vehicles in your inventory, you will be mailed a Safety Recall Notice for that specific motor home. Fleetwood is asking our dealers to make repairs to stock units on dealer lots prior to sale or lease.

Federal Law (Section 154 of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act) of 1966 requires that: If you have received a notice of recall or failure to comply from Fleetwood or any component manufacturer, you must repair or otherwise correct the defects on vehicle remaining in your inventory according to the notification, before selling or leasing the vehicles. Any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of the notice to the lessee within ten days.

Please review this entire package with your parts and service staff to familiarize them with the step-by-step procedure and implement the Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign.
