Re: Safety Defect Report

Dear Mr. Smith:

On May 21, 2009, Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc. decided that a safety defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain motor homes as listed below, and is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on May 22, 2009.
  - Fleetwood has assigned 90521 as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiary of Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in the recall are certain 2009 and 2010 model year Jamboree, Tioga Ranger and Jamboree Sport class C model motor homes built on Ford E450 chassis and manufactured from: April 15, 2009 to May 13, 2009.

The May 13, 2009 date coincides with a revised procedure being implemented during production to prevent brake line leakage.

These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of:  
789GA4701509 through 789GA4701558  
789MA4701519 through 789MA4701538  
788N94701384 through 788NA4701472  
751UA4701475

- (3) Fleetwood reports approximately 61 as the number of Jamboree, Tioga Ranger and Jamboree Sport class C model motor homes built on Ford E450 chassis that contain the safety defect.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 1% of the affected Jamboree, Tioga Ranger and Jamboree Sport class C model motor homes built on Ford E450 chassis contain the safety defect.
- (5) On certain 2009 and 2010 model year Jamboree, Tioga Ranger and Jamboree Sport model motor homes built on Ford E450 chassis that have had the wheelbases extended, have also required an extended brake line. The brake line extension has been identified as a potential source for brake fluid leaks.

Loss of brake fluid may result in longer stopping distances and/or loss of brakes. Loss of brakes may result in a vehicle crash.

- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in April, 2009 after a Fleetwood customer reported the motor home brake warning light indicator illuminated.

Fleetwood is not aware of any accidents or injuries that have resulted from this safety defect.

- (8) Fleetwood will inspect or have a Ford dealership inspect and if necessary replace the brake line extension and/or connection fittings.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification by e-mail on July 3, 2009.

Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification on July 7, 2009.


Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.
